RESOLVE, in Favor of Henry M. Salisbury, Compensating
Him for Damages.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to
2 be paid to Henry M. Salisbury of Otis, to compensate him
3 for damages on his car caused by a moose, the sum of two
4 hundred dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Salisbury was driving along the highway, north of Ells Falls on the Bangor road, when a moose jumped from the thicket beside the road. The car hit him and he fell, making the car swerve so that it crossed the road and struck a telephone pole and badly injured it.
