RESOLVE, in Favor of Anton R. Jordan, Compensating Him for Damages.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the 2 sum of forty-three dollars and fifty cents to be paid to An-3 ton R. Jordan of Osborn, to compensate said Anton R. Jor-4 dan for damages sustained in an accident with a moose.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Jordan was attacked by a moose on the road from Waltham to Osborn while driving on the highway. His automobile's lamps, hood and radiator were destroyed. He lost the use of his car for three weeks and had to hire another. The life of his family as well as himself was endangered.
