RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Alfred, for Reimbursement of Amount Expended for the Care and Maintenance of Florence Thibert, a State Pauper.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to
2 be paid to the town of Alfred, to reimburse it for the
3 amount expended for the care and maintenance of Flor-
4 ence Thibert, a state pauper, the sum of five hundred twen-
5 ty-seven dollars and thirty-five cents.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Florence Thibert was a state pauper, she was taken to the Eye and Ear Infirmary for treatment. She later died. No residence could be found in Maine.
