IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Stephen Beattie, for Reimbursement for Sheep Killed and Injured by Dogs.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated, to 2 be paid Stephen Beattie, to reimburse him for sheep killed 3 and injured by dogs, the sum of sixty dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

During the year nineteen hundred twenty-two several sheep were killed and injured by dogs and the selectmen of the town were notified but no action was taken, and said Stephen Beattie has never received any reimbursement from the town or state.
