RESOLVE, in Favor of Mary S. Beattie, for Reimbursement for Sheep and Lambs Killed by Dogs.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated, to be 2 paid to Mary S. Beattie, to reimburse her for sheep and 3 lambs killed by dogs, the sum of fifty-two dollars fifty cents.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

During the year nineteen hundred twenty-four one sheep and two lambs were killed by dogs and the selectmen of the town were notified but no action was taken, and said Mary S. Beattie has never received any reimbursement from the town or state.
