STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Stetson.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to
2 be paid to the town of Stetson, to reimburse it for the
3 amount expended for medical support for Orren Berry, a
4 world war veteran, the sum of fifty-six dollars and fifty
5 cents.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Orren A. Berry, a world war veteran came to Stetson during the summer of nineteen hundred twenty-three and was taken ill on January thirteenth, nineteen hundred twenty-four. An emergency operation was necessary and he was taken to the Plummer Memorial Hospital at Dexter where he was operated on by Dr. Sheldon of Stetson, and Dr. Emerson of Newport. This resolve is to reimburse the town of Stetson for money paid for conveyance to hospital, operation and cost of operative treatment. Said Berry had no pauper residence that could be ascertained.
