STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Eight of Chapter Two Hundred Twenty-four of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-three, as Amended, Relating to the Use of Monies Received from the Tax on Gasoline, Conditional on an Amendment to the Constitution to Authorize Highway and Bridge Bonds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. Section eight of chapter two hundred twenty2 four of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-three,
3 as amended by chapter two hundred twelve of the public
4 laws of nineteen hundred twenty-five, as amended by chap5 ter two hundred fifty-one of the public laws of nineteen

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6 hundred twenty-seven, is hereby further amended by strik-7 ing out the words "eighteen and three-quarters" in the third 8 and fourth lines thereof and inserting therein the word 9 'fifty,' and by striking out the words "twenty-five" in the 10 seventh line thereof and inserting therein the words 'thirty-11 seven and one-half,' and by striking out after the word 12 "highways" in the eighth line thereof the words "it being 13 the intention of the legislature to make this appropriation 14 available for the fiscal year of nineteen hundred and twenty-15 eight; forty-three and three-quarters per cent thereof shall 16 be used for the construction or reconstruction of state high-17 ways," so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 8. All moneys received through the provisions of 2 this act by the treasurer of state shall be appropriated and 3 used in the following manner, namely: fifty per cent there-4 of for the maintenance of state and state aid highways, 5 interstate, intrastate and international bridges; twelve and 6 one-half per cent thereof shall be added to the balance of 7 the fund for the construction of third class highways; thirty-8 seven and one-half per cent thereof shall be added to the 9 fund for construction of state aid highways. Any unex-10 pended balances from the above apportionments shall not 11 lapse but shall be carried forward to the same fund for the 12 next fiscal year, except that any balance of the appropria-13 tion herein made for the construction of state aid high-14 ways, after allotments in full as applied for by the towns 15 have been made yearly, shall be added to the fund for con-

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16 struction of third class highways. If the moneys, provided 17 for by this section, have not been collected or for any reason 18 are not available for the purposes herein specified, the 19 governor and council may issue their warrant to the treasur-20 er of state, authorizing him to advance and pay from any 21 moneys then in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, 22 such sums of money as they may deem necessary to carry 23 on the construction and maintenance of highways and 24 bridges, until such time as said moneys shall become avail-25 able for said purposes, at which time all necessary adjust-26 ments may be made on the books of the state auditor and 27 state treasurer.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of 2 January, nineteen hundred thirty, provided, however, that 3 the resolve passed by the eighty-fourth legislature provid-4 ing for an amendment to section seventeen of article nine 5 of the constitution of the state therein increasing the amount 6 of state bonds which the legislature may authorize to be 7 issued for the purpose of building state highways and inter-8 state, intrastate and international bridges, is adopted by 9 votes given in by the inhabitants of the various cities, towns 10 and plantations, voting on said amendment in accordance 11 with the provisions of said resolve as required by the con-12 solution.
