STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the City of Lewiston for Support
of John Knupstis and Family, State Paupers.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to
2 be paid to the city of Lewiston, the sum of one hundred
3 seventy-one dollars and ninety-five cents, to reimburse said
4 city for money expended for support of John Knupstis and
5 family, state paupers.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve covers assistance furnished this family by the City of Lewiston in 1924 and 1925. It was supposed at the time the aid was given that the family belonged in the town of Rumford, and for that reason no claim was made against the state. When it was learned that the family had no pauper settlement in the state, it was too late for payment of the bills without special resolve of the legislature.
