STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Providing for a Statue of Hannibal Hamlin to be Placed in the National Statuary Hall at Washington.

Resolved: That the governor and council be, and are 2 hereby, authorized to contract with some suitable artist, a 3 native of Maine, for a statue of Hannibal Hamlin, in 4 bronze, to be placed in the national statuary hall at Wash-5 ington, and that a sum of money not to exceed eight thou-6 sand dollars be expended therefor. This appropriation to 7 be taken from funds in the treasury not otherwise appro-8 priated.
