IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Rumford for Support of the Family of Harry Keyo.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to 2 be paid to the town of Rumford, the sum of eighty-three 3 dollars, to reimburse said town for money expended for 4 support of the family of Harry Keyo.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve covers the amount paid by the town of Rumford for board of the family of Harry Keyo. Part of his life was spent in the woods, working as a lumberman. The Overseers of Poor of Rumford have never been able to find that he had a legal pauper settlement anywhere in the State.
