IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Rumford for Support of Edson Batcheldor.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to 2 be paid to the town of Rumford, the sum of one hundred 3 twenty-eight dollars and thirty-eight cents, to reimburse said 4 town for money expended for support of Edson Batcheldor.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve covers the amount paid by the town of Rumford for board, care and medical services for this pauper. He has spent his life principally working as a farm laborer and woodsman. The Overseers of the Poor of Rumford have never been able to find that he had a legal pauper settlement anywhere in the State. Ill health was the reason for falling into distress.
