Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to
2 be paid to the O. B. Frost Company of Augusta, Maine,
3 the sum of five thousand six hundred five dollars and thirty-
4 two cents on account of loss sustained by said company on
5 the Randolph-Pittston bridge job, so-called.
