STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Abbie M. Walker of Norridgewock,
Maine, for Destruction of Chickens by Foxes.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of fifty dollars to be paid to Abbie M. Walker of Nor-
3 ridgewock, Somerset county, compensation for the destruc-
4 tion of chickens by foxes in said Norridgewock.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In August, 1927, Abbie M. Walker of Norridgewock was the owner of about 500 well grown chickens. Thirty of these were found dead, killed by foxes. It was evident, also, that others had been killed and eaten. Mrs. Walker suffered, thereby, a loss of at least fifty dollars.
