RESOLVE, in Favor of the County of Lincoln, for Reimbursement.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to 2 be paid the county of Lincoln, for reimbursement of ex-3 penses incurred in the burial of an unknown person found 4 on the shore of Monhegan Island, the sum of sixty dollars.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This body was found on the shore of Monhegan Island, a plantation. It was buried at the expense of the county of Lincoln.
