RESOLVE, in Favor of George H. Starret, Compensating Him for Damages.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the

2 sum of three thousand one hundred fifty dollars to be paid

3 to George H. Starret, of Thomaston, Knox county, to com-

4 pensate him for damages sustained by raising the grade of

5 the state road in front of his buildings.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

George H. Starret owned the buildings at the east end of the Mill Creek Bridge in Thomaston. The grade was raised and the selectmen awarded three hundred dollars for damages. Suit was brought by Mr. Starret against the town for damages which amounted to three thousand one hundred fifty dollars. It is in care now of the same court.
