# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Frank E. Downes.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to 2 be paid to Frank E. Downes of Winterport, to compensate 3 him for acting as administrator of the estate of Cyrenus 4 B. Downes, the sum of eighteen hundred dollars.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Cyrenus B. Downes was drafted for the Civil War in August, eighteen hundred sixty-three. His wife was sick and he hired three hundred dollars at twenty per cent interest with which he paid a substitute. Later his wife recovering he enlisted in the army and served until the close of the war.

This is the interest on the amount he hired.
