Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of thirty-one dollars, to be paid to the estate of Millard 3 P. Hanson, M. D., of Patten, for services rendered the

4 family of William R. Alexander of Island Falls.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

William R. Alexander and family had assistance as state paupers in the town of Island Falls in 1927 and 1928. They disappeared from that town in 1928, and it is supposed that they returned to Canada. This resolve is for services rendered by the late Dr. Hanson, apparently without any order from the overseers of poor of Island Falls.
