Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to
2 be paid to the town of Leeds, for reimbursement of ex-
3 penses incurred for the supplies furnished and funeral ex-
4 penses of William Dyer, a pauper, the sum of one hundred
5 sixty-seven dollars and seventy cents.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The expenses of this pauper were supposed to be on the town of Roxbury, which is disputed. His legal residence cannot be found.
