RESOLVE, in Favor of Edwin F. Fowler for Reimbursement for Damage Done His Poultry by Coons.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of fifty dollars to be paid Edwin F. Fowler to reim-3 burse him for damage done his poultry last October by 4 coons.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Thirty hen and pullets were killed by coons at Fowler's Camps on Lower Shin Pond last October, this being during the period when coons are protected by law.
