RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Wellington for Support  
of E. Leroy Braley and Family, State Paupers.

---

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to  
2 be paid to the town of Wellington, the sum of forty-five  
3 dollars and sixty cents, to reimburse said town for money  
4 expended for support of E. Leroy Braley and family, state  
5 paupers.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve is to cover the amount furnished by the town of Wellington for support of this family in February and March, 1927. The family left the town of Wellington very soon thereafter and the overseers of poor of the town have never been able to locate them since that time. Mr. Braley claimed that they came from Connecticut.
