RESOLVE, in Favor of the City of Hallowell.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated to
2 be paid to the city of Hallowell, in the county of Kennebec
3 and state of Maine, the sum of one hundred fifty-three dol-
4 lars and forty cents (\$153.40) for overpaid taxes to the
5 state of Maine in nineteen hundred and twenty-seven.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Hallowell Granite Works, a corporation doing business in Hallowell, petitioned for an abatement of a portion of its 1927 taxes; the matter was referred to the state assessors who ordered an abatement in the sum of one hundred forty-two dollars and six cents (\$142.06), decree of abatement became effective at the October term 1928 of the Kennebec county Supreme Judicial Court; meanwhile the city of Hallowell had paid the state for 1927 taxes as per original assessment; as the state assessors ordered that the Hallowell Granite Works pay one hundred forty-two dollars and six cents (\$142.06) less than the amount paid by the city of Hallowell to the state the city asks reimbursement by the state of said amount and interest.
