IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Henry Soucie, of Township Number
Fourteen, Range Six, Aroostook County, Maine.

Resolved: That the sum of sixty-four dollars be and is
2 hereby appropriated to reimburse Henry Soucie for damage
3 done his oat crop by deer, season of nineteen hundred twen-
4 ty-three.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In view of the fact that the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game is no longer permitted to approve financial reimbursement for damage done growing crops by deer, this resolve, in favor of Henry Soucie, of township fourteen, range six, Aroostook county, is introduced at this time for the purpose of reimbursing him for damage sustained during the season of nineteen hundred twenty-three.

Hereunto attached is statement of the game wardens who examined his oat field.
