STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of E. M. Wylie, for Reimbursement.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to
2 be paid to E. M. Wylie of Gardiner, to reimburse him for
3 capturing four prisoners escaped from the state prison, the
4 sum of two hundred dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The chief of police took Mr. Wylie with his police dogs to track the escaped men. The dogs tracked the men and they were arrested and returned to prison. Mr. Wylie desires the same amount as is usually paid for such a capture.
