STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Prohibit the Trapping of Foxes in the County of Cumberland for Five Years.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whoever within a period of five years from the time this 2 act takes effect shall catch by means of a trap any fox 3 within the county of Cumberland and whoever has in pos-4 session during said period any fox or parts thereof taken 5 in a trap in said county shall pay a fine of fifty dollars and 6 costs for each offense and in addition thereto three dollars 7 for each fox trapped, caught or had in possession in viola-8 tion hereof.
