STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Permit Residents of Readfield in Kennebec County
to Fish Through the Ice in Lake Maranacook in Said County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful for residents of Readfield in
2 Kennebec county to fish through the ice for pickerel and
3 perch on Thursday of each week in that part of Lake
4 Maranacook in said county which is north of the line sepa-
5 rating Readfield from Winthrop in said county.

Sect. 2. Any person violating section one shall be deemed
2 guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not exceeding
3 thirty dollars for each offence. All fines shall be paid to
4 the state and made a part of the fund used to protect fish
5 and game.
