IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Closing Songo Pond in the Towns of Albany and
Bethel, in Oxford County, to Ice Fishing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for,
2 take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time, on or through
3 the ice in Songo pond, which pond is situated in the towns
4 of Albany and Bethel, in the county of Oxford.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall
2 be subject to a fine of not less than ten dollars and not more
3 than twenty dollars.
