#### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Regulate the Taking of Muskrats on East Machias
River, in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt,

- 2 trap, kill, pursue or catch any muskrat or muskrats in or on
- 3 the banks of the East Machias river from the tide waters
- 4 to the Moosehorn camping grounds, or any tributary there-
- 5 to, in the county of Washington, or in any lake connected
- 6 therewith, in said county of Washington; except it shall be
- 7 lawful to take muskrats on said river from March fifteenth
- 8 to May fifteenth, both days inclusive, of each year.

Sect. 2. It shall also be unlawful for any person to have 2 in possession at any time any muskrat or muskrats taken 3 in violation of this act.
