STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Regulate Ice Fishing in the Belgrade Chain of Lakes, So-called, in the Counties of Kennebec and Somerset.

Section 1. So much of the rules and regulations of the 2 department of inland fisheries and game now in force as 3 prohibits fishing through the ice, in accordance with the

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

4 general law of the state, in the Belgrade chain of lakes, so-

5 called, situated partly in the county of Kennebec, partly in

6 the county of Somerset, on Thursday of each week, during

7 the months of February and March of each year, is hereby

8 repealed.

- Sect. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch, 2 kill, or have in possession in any one day, more than seven 3 fish in all taken through the ice in said Belgrade chain of 4 lakes.
- Sect. 3. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars, nor more 3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and one dollar 4 additional for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in possession in violation of any provision of this act.
