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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT Relating to Wards in the City of Portland.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The city shall remain divided into nine wards  
2 unless and until the city council shall change the number  
3 thereof as hereinafter provided. It shall be the duty of  
4 the city council, not oftener than once in ten years, to raise,  
5 and if be needful, to alter such wards in such manner as  
6 to preserve as nearly as may be, an equal number of voters  
7 in each and the city council may in such manner, change  
8 the number of wards.

Sect. 2. All acts, parts of acts, inconsistent herewith, are  
2 hereby repealed.
