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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT Relating to the Charter of the City of Saco.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter two hundred and fifteen of the  
2 special laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and  
3 sixty-seven is hereby amended by striking out the whole  
4 of said section and substituting therefor the following:

'Sect. 5. Every law, act, ordinance, or bill appropriating  
2 money, having passed the city council, shall be presented  
3 to the mayor, and if he approves the same, he shall sign  
4 it, if not, he shall return it within seven days, with his  
5 objections, to the city council, which shall enter the objec-  
6 tions at large on its records and proceed to reconsider said

7 law, act, ordinance or bill. If, upon such reconsideration,  
8 two-thirds of the whole number of members of the city  
9 council shall agree to pass it, and so vote, it shall have the  
10 same effect as if signed by the mayor, and it shall be the  
11 duty of the mayor to sign any warrant necessary for the  
12 execution of such law, act, ordinance or bill, and in case  
13 of his refusal, the city council may order the treasurer to  
14 pay the same, and its order shall be sufficient authority and  
15 voucher for the treasurer so to do.
