STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Authorizing the City of Lewiston to Issue its Bond to the Amount of One Hundred and Twenty-five Thousand Dollars to Repair and Build Addition to High School in the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Said city of Lewiston is authorized to issue bonds to re-

- 2 pair and build an addition to its high school; terms and in-
- 3 terest rate. To repair and build an addition to the high
- 4 school in the city of Lewiston, the city of Lewiston is here-
- 5 by authorized to issue its bonds to an amount not exceed-
- 6 ing one hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars payable
- 7 at a period not to exceed twenty years and bearing interest

8 at a rate not to exceed four and one-half per cent per angunum payable semi-annually. Said bonds shall be issued in serial form and shall be payable in the following manner, it to wit: Five thousand dollars in one year from date of issuance and five thousand dollars on each and every year thereafter until said issue is fully paid; said bonds shall be issued under the seal of the city and shall be signed by the mayor and treasurer of the city, and the coupons attached thereto shall have the printed or lithographed signature of the treasurer.
