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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT to Make Valid Copies of Records of Instruments  
Affecting or Conveying Title to Real Estate in the County  
of Knox and Recorded in Other Counties.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The copies of all instruments and plans made  
2 by the commissioner appointed under the provisions of  
3 chapter seventy-eight of the private and special laws of  
4 nineteen hundred and twenty-one, taken from the records  
5 of the clerk of courts and registry of probate as well as  
6 the registry of deeds of the counties of Lincoln, Waldo and  
7 Hancock, and contained in volumes one to fifty-seven, both

8 inclusive, now deposited in Knox registry of deeds and  
9 labelled "Lincoln, Waldo and Hancock Records of Knox  
10 Lands" are hereby ratified, confirmed and made valid. Such  
11 instruments and plans may be used in evidence and for  
12 any other purposes the same as the original records.

Sect. 2. The card index of said records prepared by the  
2 commissioner appointed under said act, is hereby accepted  
3 in lieu of the ledger index provided for in section two of  
4 said chapter seventy-eight.
