IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE in Favor of Roxie A. Benner of Jefferson in the County of Lincoln for Mother's Aid.

Resolved: That a mother's aid of twenty-five dollars per 2 month be, and hereby is, granted to Roxie A. Benner of 3 Jefferson in the county of Lincoln, a widow with three 4 small children dependent upon her and without any finan-5 cial means whatever, to be paid quarterly from the regular 6 appropriation for mother's aid. Said mother's aid shall be-7 gin on July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and 8 continue until said children become sixteen years of age 9 or until otherwise provided by the legislature.
