# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing the Amount of the Exemption from Taxation of Household Furniture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Paragraph IV of section six of chapter ten of the revised 2 statutes is amended by striking out the words "two hundred 3 dollars" in the first and second line thereof and inserting in 4 place thereof the words 'five hundred dollars' so that said 5 section as amended shall read as follows:

'IV. The household furniture of each person, not exceed-2 ing five hundred dollars to any one family, his wearing 3 apparel, farming utensils, mechanics' tools necessary for his 4 business, and musical instruments not exceeding in value 5 fifty dollars to one family.'
