IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Catching of Lobsters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

It shall be lawful at any time to set a trap or other device
2 used for catching lobsters and to take and catch lobsters
3 within the following described limits from Jordan Island in
4 Gouldsboro to Egg Rock, thence easterly to Schoodic Point
5 Whistling Buoy, thence by the shore into Winter Harbor.
