STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Change the Name of the Town of East Livermore to the Town of Livermore Falls.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section .1. From and after the date when this act takes
2 effect the name of the town of East Livermore, in the coun3 ty of Androscoggin, shall cease and said town shall there4 after be called and known by the name of Livermore Falls.
5 Said town of Livermore Falls shall have and possess all the
6 rights and privileges, and be subject to all and the same
7 obligations and liabilities of the town of East Livermore.

Sect. 2. This act shall go into effect upon acceptance of

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2 the same by the voters of the town of East Livermore, at3 any annual meeting called by a warrant containing an article4 for the purpose.

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
