IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relative to Temporary Number Plates on Motor
Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. A manufacturer or dealer shall, upon the sale
2 or exchange of a motor vehicle, attach to such motor ve-
3 hicle a set of temporary number plates, and the purchaser
4 of such motor vehicle may operate the same for a period
5 not to exceed five consecutive days thereafter without pay-
6 ment of a registration fee.

Sect. 2. A manufacturer or dealer shall, upon attaching
2 a set of temporary number plates to a motor vehicle sold

3 or exchanged by him, immediately notify the secretary of
4 state of said sale or exchange, giving the name and address
5 of the purchaser, the number on the temporary plate, and
6 such further information as the secretary of state may
7 require.
