STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Confirming and Making Valid Certain Licenses or
Permits Given by the Selectmen of Hancock, Maine, and
Vesting in the Consolidated Lobster Company, Inc., Certain
Rights and Property in Lobster Pounds, Wharf and Dams
in the Waters of Skillings River on the West Side of Han-
cock Point in Hancock, Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The licenses or permits dated February twen-
2 ty-three, nineteen hundred and eleven and June twenty-six,
3 nineteen hundred and twenty-two respectively, granted to
4 J. W. Stinson and J. W. Stinson and son respectively, re-
5 lating to the erecting and maintaining a lobster pound, wharf

6 and dams in the waters of Skillings river on the west side
7 of Hancock Point in Hancock, Maine, and the assignments,
8 dated December five, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight
9 relating to said licenses or permits, from said J. W. Stinson
10 (John W. Stinson) and said John W. Stinson and Calvin
11 L. Stinson individually and as co-partners as J. W. Stinson
12 and son, to the Consolidated Lobster Company, Inc., a cor-
13 poration organized under the laws of the Commonwealth
14 of Massachusetts and having its principal office or place of
15 business at Boston, county of Suffolk, in said common-
16 wealth, are hereby ratified, confirmed and made valid.

Sect. 2. The said Consolidated Lobster Company, Inc.,
2 its successors and assigns, are hereby granted the right to
3 maintain and use, the lobster pounds, wharf, dams and
4 structures in the waters of Skillings river on the west side
5 of Hancock Point in Hancock, Maine, as the same have
6 been maintained and used by said John W. Stinson, said
7 Calvin L. Stinson or said J. W. Stinson and son or any one
8 or more of them.
