, RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Stetson.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to
2 be paid to the town of Stetson, to reimburse it for the
3 amount expended for the care and maintenance of Leora
4 Smith, a pauper, the sum of ninety dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Leora Smith, daughter of Eugene Smith, a former state pauper, when residing in Dexter, Maine, visited Stetson and while there was delivered of a still-born child. She suffered from septicarmia and was ill for nearly three months in the winter of nineteen hundred twenty-four. This resolve is to reimburse the town of Stetson for money paid for obstetrical and post obstetrical services and care during convalescence.
