STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Quarantine of Cattle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Chapter thirty-five of the revised statutes as amended by 2 chapter twenty-four of the public laws of nineteen hundred 3 twenty-five, is hereby further amended by striking out in 4 the twenty-fourth section thereof, the words "such quaran-5 tine to remain until all animals within the area designated 6 shall be subject to the tuberculin test or other test or exam-7 ination satisfactory to the commissioner of agriculture or 8 his agent"; so that said section as amended shall read, as 9 follows:

'Sect. 24. Commissioner of agriculture authorized to pro-

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2 hibit moving of cattle to and from quarantined areas; ani-3 mals brought into said area may be quarantined.

The commissioner of agriculture or his agent in charge of 2 live stock sanitary work is hereby empowered to prohibit 3 the movement of cattle of every description into or from 4 any area where bovine tuberculosis or other contagious 5 disease is known to exist and where the commissioner of 6 agriculture or his agent has assumed charge of such disease 7 eradication. If any animals are brought into any such area 8 in violation of this regulation the commissioner of agricul-9 ture or his agent shall be further empowered to quarantine 10 such animals until they shall be tested by an accredited 11 veterinarian at the expense of the owner.'

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
