IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of Registry of Deeds for Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph nine of section forty-five of chapter one hun-2 dred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is 3 hereby further amended by striking out in the second para-

4 graph thereof the word six and inserting in place thereof

5 the word 'eight' so the said paragraph as amended shall read 6 as follows:

'Lincoln county: for clerks in the office of register of 2 deeds, eight hundred dollars; for clerks in the office of reg-

- 3 ister of probate, one hundred sixty dollars; for clerks in
- 4 the office of clerk of courts, two hundred dollars.'
