## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fire Protection.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All money received from taxes upon the premiums of all

- 2 classes of insurance companies shall be applied as follows:
- 3 first such portion thereof which may be necessary for the
- 4 maintenance of the insurance department and expenses inci-
- 5 dental thereto; second, the remainder shall be apportioned
- 6 equally amongst the several towns which maintain a regu-
- 7 larly organized fire company together with fire apparatus
- 8 for fighting fire; such money shall be forwarded to the
- 9 treasurer of such towns on the first day of May in each

10 year next following, the collection of such taxes and shall
11 be used for the sole purpose of the maintenance of such
12 fire department; if in any year, a balance should remain
13 unexpended, such sum shall be carried forward and held
14 by the town until it is needed for the said purpose.
