STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fishing in Inland Waters in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to take and catch smelts
2 in all the inland waters within the county of York, above
3 tide waters, with a net.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the provision of this act shall
2 pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty
3 dollars and costs for each offense and in addition thereto,
4 one dollar for each fish taken and caught in violation of
5 this act.
