STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Taxes Upon Mortgaged Real Estate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Any person, firm or corporation who holds

- 2 a mortgage on a piece of real estate may pay the taxes on
- 3 such property, any time after legal proceeding to collect
- 4 the taxes on such property has commenced or one year
- 5 after such tax was assessed and the amount, so paid shall
- 6 become a part of the mortgage debt, at the same rate of
- 7 interest as the mortgage notes, but if the notes vary in the
- 8 rates on interest the lowest rate shall prevail, and interest
- 9 rated from the date of such payment.

Sect. 2. This act is to affect all mortgages acknowledged 2 after it becomes a law.
