STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Nineteen of Chapter Thirty-five of the Revised Statutes, Relative to the Jurisdiction of Courts over Offenses under said Chapter.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section nineteen of chapter thirty-five of the revised stat-

- 2 utes is hereby amended by striking out the words "the su-
- 3 preme judicial court and superior courts shall have juris-
- 4 diction of such offenses" in the third and fourth lines of
- 5 said section and by inserting in place thereof the words
- 6 'trial justices, police and municipal courts within their coun-
- 7 ties shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent

8 jurisdiction with the supreme judicial court and superior 9 courts in all prosecutions arising under this chapter,' so to that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 19. County attorneys shall prosecute violations.

2 The several county attorneys shall prosecute all violations

3 of this chapter, which shall be brought to their notice or

4 knowledge by any person making the complaint under oath;

5 trial justices, police and municipal courts within their coun
6 ties shall have upon complaint original and concurrent juris
7 diction with the supreme judicial court and superior courts

8 in all prosecutions arising under this chapter.'
