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**STATE OF MAINE**

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT Authorizing the City of Portland to Provide by Ordinance for the Retirement, Pension and Annuity to Dependents, of Members of the Police and Fire Departments.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That chapter seventy-five of the private and special laws  
2 of nineteen hundred and twenty-seven be amended by add-  
3 ing as section four the following:

‘Sect. 4. The city of Portland is further authorized to  
2 provide by ordinance for equalizing pensions of members  
3 of the police and fire departments and to carry into effect  
4 such equalization to pay to such members of the police and  
5 fire departments on their pension rolls as received less than

6 two dollars and fifty cents per day an added amount, so that  
7 a pension of two dollars and fifty cents per day may be  
8 paid to men on the pension rolls. The provisions of this  
9 section shall not apply to call members of the fire depart-  
10 ment now on the pension rolls.'

And that said chapter seventy-five be further amended by  
2 numbering section four as section five.
