STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Authorize the Forest Commissioner to Sell a Part
of the Public Lot in Lakeville Plantation in Penobscot
County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The forest commissioner is hereby authorized to sell and
2 convey by quit-claim deed to settlers or those occupying
3 the same such part or parts of the public lots in Lakeville
4 Plantation as are in the occupancy seasonal or permanent
5 of any citizen of this state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A lot on the westerly shore of Duck Lake in Lakeville Plantation containing approximately five acres has been in the possession or occupancy of individuals for a period of approximately thirty-five years. The last conveyance of this property is a deed from Joseph M. Burr of Eastport to Carrie M. Tupper and bears the date June twenty-ninth, nineteen hundred fourteen. This legislation is sought for the purpose of clearing up the title on said property.
