RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey to the Gould Electric Company a Certain Piece of Land on the Public Lot in Township Ten, Range Four, West of the East Line of the State, Aroostook County.

Resolved: That the forest commissioner be and hereby 2 is authorized to convey to the Gould Electric Company nine 3 acres of land from the public lot in the northeast one-4 quarter of Township ten, Range four, west of the east line 5 of the state, Aroostook county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In accordance with chapter 111, private and special laws of 1921, the Gould Electric Company built a dam at the mouth of Squa Pan Stream in Township 10, Range 4, W. E. L. S., Aroostook county, and thereby flowed nine acres of land on the public lot of said town, according to survey made by Prentiss & Carlisle Company, Inc., in August, 1928. Copy of said plan is recorded in the forest commissioner's office.
