STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section 4 of Chapter 173 of the Public
Laws of 1921 Relating to Deductions from State School
Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section four of chapter one hundred and seventy-three of
2 the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one is here-
3 by amended by adding after the word "hundred," in line
4 four, the word 'twenty-five,' so that said section as amended
5 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 4. In addition to the other funds and appropria-
2 tions provided for by law to be deducted from the state

3 school fund, there shall annually be deducted the sum of
4 one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars, the same to be
5 denominated the school equalization fund and to be appor-
6 tioned and distributed in the manner and for the purposes
7 provided for by section nine of this act. From the state
8 school fund there shall also be apportioned such sums as
9 may be required for payment to towns for reimbursement
10 of tuition in secondary schools as provided for by section
11 five of this act, and such sums as may be required for pay-
12 ment to towns on account of teaching positions maintained
13 as provided for by section six of this act, and such sums
14 as may be required for apportionment to towns on the basis
15 of school census as provided for by section seven of this
16 act, and the balance of said state school fund shall be ap-
17 portioned and distributed to towns on the basis of aggregate
18 attendance as provided for by section eight of this act.'
