STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Authorizing the State Highway Commission to
Designate County and Town Highways as Through Ways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter one hundred thirty-eight of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-seven is hereby amended by inserting the words 'and county and town ways connecting such state and state aid highways' after the word "highways" in the third line of said section, so that said section as amended will read as follows:

'Sect. 1. For the purposes of this act, the state highway commission of Maine may from time to time designate certain state and state aid highways, and county and town ways

4 connecting such state and state aid highways, as through
5 ways. Every vehicle approaching on a through way to point
6 of its intersection with a way other than a through way so
7 as to arrive at such point at approximately the same instant
8 as a vehicle approaching on such other way, shall as against
9 such other vehicle have the right of way, and every vehicle
10 immediately before entering or crossing a through way at
11 its point of intersection with another way shall first come to
12 a full stop, provided that whenever a traffic officer is sta-
13 tioned at such point, he shall have the right to regulate traf-
14 fic thereat. No such designation of a through way shall
15 become effective as to regulation of traffic at such point of
16 intersection until said commission shall have caused suitable
17 warning signs or signals to be erected at or near such point.
18 For the purposes of this act, a way joining a through way
19 at an angle, whether or not it crosses the same, shall be
20 deemed to intersect it, and the way "way" unless the con-
21 text otherwise requires, shall include a through or other
22 way.'
